

## Welding Competition Rules

- Students must arrive by 8:30AM, competition 9AM-12:30PM, lunch and awards 12:30PM-1:30PM. Competitors & mentors will be provided with a boxed lunch.
- Student must be enrolled in a High School welding course.
- Student must choose their top 2 weld processes to compete in. Depending on enrollment, student may be able to compete in up to 2 processes. The assigned welding process will be provided to the student the day of event.
- Student will have up to 60 minutes to complete project per process.
- Student must have received instruction by a sponsored teacher/instructor in the safe operation of all equipment to be used in the welding competition, and understands the personal risks involved. Both the student and the Teacher/Instructor will be asked to verify this with their signatures.
- Student must be sponsored and accompanied by a school teacher/instructor.
- Student will behave in a safe and reasonable manner.
- Student will respect all individuals involved in the competition.
- Student will perform all welds in the manner described in the weldment drawings, and no power tools will be allowed.
- Input from sponsoring teacher/instructors, once the competition begins, will not be allowed.
